Gesangbuch der Herzogl, Wirtemberg, 1784



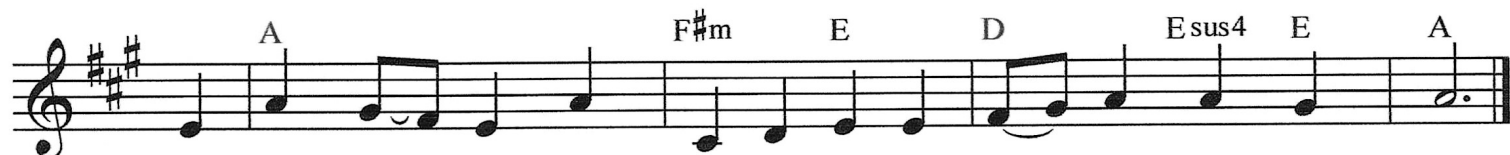
